FAQ Nova Scotia Loyal Producer Labelling Program



1. What is the Nova Scotia Loyal Producer Labelling Program?

The Nova Scotia Loyal Producer Labelling Program provides financial assistance for producers to purchase labelling products and services, including graphic design to incorporate the Nova Scotia Loyal logo onto product packaging materials, labelling dies, and first print run of labels and/or packaging materials for use on locally made products.

- 2. What is the application submission deadline? Businesses can submit completed applications for the Nova Scotia Loyal Producer Labelling Program until March 31, 2026, at 2:00 PM AST.
- What is the project/activity completion deadline? Applications will be considered for projects started and completed between February 1, 2025, and March 31, 2026.
- **4.** Is there a minimum project size or cost? Yes. The minimum project cost <u>must be no less</u> than \$500 CAD (before GST/HST).
- 5. How much of the total cost of the project does the funding cover? The total amount of all Canadian government funding (federal, provincial/territorial, or municipal) must be no more than 70% of the total eligible project cost in any single fiscal year (April 1 to March 31) to a maximum of \$3,000 CAD.
- 6. What happens if my application is approved, but plans for my project change?
